I. CALL TO ORDER

The monthly meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by President Matt McGrail.

II. REVIEW / APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Minutes of the January 9, 2006 meeting were approved as presented, noting typing errors. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Richard Green, seconded by J.T. Schokker, motion passed.

III. REPORTS

- **Treasurer:**
- Ross Strope provided a copy of the club balance sheet at 02-12-06 and a profit and loss statement for the year ended 12-31-05.
- Each team coach was provided with a listing of players with fees outstanding to the club. Ross asked that the coaches verify the listings and provide him documentation if there is an error in the reporting. He will need a copy of a cancelled check or a written explanation why the money is not owed.
- Outstanding fees as of 02-12-06 for the 2005-2006 soccer season were approximately \$7,000.00.
- The club is asking that coaches help enforce the rule that if the fees are not paid the player should not be allowed to play until they are.
- **1st Vice President:**
- Bruce Hassler reported that everything is paid and submitted for the tournament in Cape Girardeau.

- If teams need a hotel or information regarding hotels for the tournament in Cape Girardeau they should contact Bruce. He has several blocks of rooms reserved but parents need to confirm reservations as soon as possible so the rooms are not released.
- Any team participating in the Columbia Pride Tournament should submit their application to Bruce so that he can send them all in together. Bruce has secured a \$50 per team discount on the entry fee.

C. 2nd Vice President:

- Sandy asked that any coach with equipment needs please email her so she can get those items together. Her email is on the club website.

A. Uniforms:

- Cindy Hassler stated that the shorts that are owed to players from the beginning of the season are here. She will bring them to the next club meeting. If anyone needs them before then please contact her and she will make arrangements to get them to you.
- Adidas has informed us that they will no longer be making the uniform jerseys that the club currently uses. We can reserve any number that we wish and Adidas will make them for us. We are under no obligation to purchase these. Cindy stated that her supply of youth jerseys is very limited. She asked the board for their recommendation on reserving jerseys.

E. Website:

- Rob Davis reported that he will change the way that he reports on the website usage. Prior the report was based on number of hits, which reports every page that is clicked on. Rob will be reporting on number of visits, which tells how many times the club web site is accessed regardless of number of pages looked at.
- January had 1,166 visits with the top three pages being Tournaments, Team, and Officials. February thru 02-12-06 had 291 with the top three pages being Tournaments, Teams and Club info.

IV. DIRECTOR OF COACHING

G. Doug Marcus:

- Doug reported that he is still having trouble finding a place to hold an E license clinic but will keep trying.
- Doug will be putting together a booklet of info for the coaches related to knowledge he has gained from recent coaching classes.

V. COMMITTEES:

H. JCYSL

- Matt McGrail reported that the meetings have been moved to quarterly and they meet last week.
- There are 4 teams practicing at 63 Sports with the remainder of the club practicing at 179.
- Any teams practicing at 63 Sports need to have written consent from each parent on their team to practice there.
- U14-16-18 boys will practice on Monday and Wednesday nights on fields 5 & 6.
- All others will practice on Tuesday and Thursday nights. Matt will advise each coach of

field assignment later in the week.

- Fields at 179 will be open for practice beginning 02-27-06. There is currently no maintenance person available for these fields. Contact Matt McGrail if you need anything.
- Discussion took place regarding the stripping of the fields. There is a possibility of getting a group together to do this and to clean out the shed at 179.

I. CMSL:

- There will be a mandatory meeting for all league coaches on 02-18-06 from 1-5 pm at Tucker Hall in Columbia. Please notify Matt McGrail if you are unable to attend.
- Discussion ensued regarding the upcoming vote for new board members for CMSL. Bruce Hassler will clarify voting rules with CMSL.

J. JCCVB:

- Matt McGrail has filed an application to be a member of JCCVB Athletic committee.
- Cindy Hassler reported that she applied for and was accepted for a grant from JCCVB. They will donate \$500 to our club to be used for the rental of golf carts at our tournaments. We must provide signs on the golf carts that state they are compliments of the JCCVB.

L. Tournaments:

- Cindy Hassler and Doug Marcus are the new Tournament Co-Directors
- Coaches were reminded to inform their teams that they will now be required to work at TWO tournaments each season, rather than only one as previously done.
- It was noted that Doug Marcus is coordinating the effort to have medical trainers on site at tournaments rather than pay an ambulance to be there.
- Cindy stated that CMSRA has approved all 4 of our tournaments for 2006.
- Cindy stated that there will be a registration night on Friday, March 31, 2006 for our first tournament. All local coaches, including our own teams, must register on Friday night. Registration will be at Hotel Deville.
- There are forms available if anyone is interested in advertising in the tournament book. We are doing business advertising as well as “happy ads” if anyone is interested.

- Each team present gave an update on what they were doing during the off season.

VII. OLD BUSINESS:

M. AGM – Columbia, MO February 10-12

- Many of our coaching staff attended this meeting. Discussion ensued regarding information gathered at the event. Overall everyone thought this was a good event.
- Bruce Hassler was nominated for Girls Coach of the Year.
- Doug Marcus discussed the USYSA meeting that will be held next year in St. Louis. He encouraged all coaches to begin thinking ahead and plan to attend if possible.

N. Tryouts for 2006-2007

- A date was set for tryouts for next season. The dates are June 23, 24, and 25.
- A tryout committee will be formed. Anyone interested in participating should contact Bruce Hassler.

VIII. OTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD:

- Matt McGrail reminded everyone of the proper respect that should be shown to all referees, especially the youth refs.
- Kevin Dermody is starting up a U-8 team to play modified rec soccer through the YMCA. This will facilitate the movement of those children into the club next year as a U-9 team. Contact Kevin if you are interested.
- There will be open gym nights for the next two Sunday evenings beginning 02-19-06. These will take place at the Ellis YMCA. Time for 02-19-06 is 7:00-8:30. All players are welcome to attend.
- Kevin Wideman resigned as Secretary effective 02-13-06. A new Secretary will be elected at the March meeting. Contact Matt McGrail if you are interested in the position. Matt thanked Kevin for his past service to the club!
